RACE REPORT

Little Boreas – PHRF Racing is alive and well As Peggy, Kathryn and I met for the first planning meeting a few weeks ago, there were only two entries and we were worried the event might be a bust. As it turns out, our concerns were not realized. Shortly there after a steady stream of entries came in during the remaining weeks. One even signed up in the last 10 minutes before the deadline. In all, 15 boats entered, 14 started and 12 finished and unfortunately, 2 DNF'd. According to one entrant from Santa Cruz, many in their fleet have been looking for a race like this to happen for quite a while. He mentioned the craving for a simple, semi-longish, downwind race to a destination harbor like Moss Landing. He went on to say doing the same local round the buoy races in Santa Cruz was getting a bit stale and tiresome. Enter the Little Boreas and, "voila!"

The start in Santa Cruz was facilitated by the SCYC. They allowed us to use their club to hold the Skipper's meeting and use their Committee Boat and expert management crew to facilitate the noon start. Everyone behaved nicely and the start came off without drama. We quickly pulled anchor and sped back to the harbor so I could drive to ML and out to the Finish line before the first boat crossed the line. It was very close. A we motored out on Damien Wayne's borrowed boat "Spirit," we could see the Spinnakers of Hijinx and Kemosabe coming toward us off in the distance. It was close, but we managed to anchor about 5 minutes before Hijinx crossed. Whew!

As Kemosabe approached, their last Gybe went terribly wrong and they encountered a bad rap. Damien and I watched in horror as they struggled a half dozen times to clear it and eventually enter the harbor out of control. We were very worried for them. Unknown to us, John Martinelli smartly deployed his anchor to stop the boat just before hitting the bridge! Another Whew!

Regardless, our job was to take the finish times of all the other boats coming behind, so we put our concerns aside and got back to monitoring the finishes. Shortly thereafter we could see three boats running very closely together. These turned out to be the three Santa Cruz 27's in a very tight battle, and they crossed the line in quick succession with only a few seconds of separation. These three boats ended up correcting out as the top three award winning finishers. Some might say the conditions suited the SC27's, but Rocket Science and Hijinx finished only a few seconds behind this group. It is my feeling the three SC27 pushed each other the full race distance for the "one design" bragging rights, but this also helped push them to the top of the order. The remarkable thing is the top 5 boats finished with a 22 second time span. Holly Cow Bat Man!

After the race, all the competitors came to the club to mingle, receive their awards and partake of Peggy Carroll's fine cooking. She is a fabulous cook, extremely organized, reliable and a competent manager. I am very lucky to have her helping me with the racing program and the event planning. Thank you Peggy!




