JANUARY BOARD MEETING BRIEFS

Reports

Commodore Rita Jacques-Thank you to everyone for helping to get our new manager and bookkeeper in place. Invoices for the quarterly dues have not gone out yet, the bookkeeper is trying to bring everything up to date. We've been talking about sending invoices by email. It takes 60 cents now to mail a letter times 160 members. We will be emailing the membership about this before it happens and anyone opposed to it can contact the office to have an invoice mailed to them. She recognized DiAnn Tarhalla for working on the website. The gates to the club property were closed and locked from 4 January to 5 January 2024

<u>Treasure Stacy Hughes-</u> The Budget was presented and major changes in expenses were the employee salaries. First attempt of the budget was about a 30,000 deficit. To fix that deficit the approach was 1. To increase bar sales by 13%. 2. To impose a dues increase of \$100 dollars a year for flag members and other categories would go up proportionally. Dues have not increased in at least the last 5 years. 3.Looking at having closing hours for bartenders to reduce the overtime. Other small adjustments were made. All the adjustments corrected the deficit. Toni made a motion to increase Flag membership by \$100 a year. Hillary seconded. Discussion was held. All approved.

Jim made a motion to approve the budget, Toni second, Discussion was held, All approved.

<u>Club Manager: Melissa Raney</u> - We are having problems with the phone line. She is more than happy to give out her cell phone number to anyone that needs it, If not please email her. She is in the officeWednesday thru Saturday. They are looking into possibly changing the phone carrier.

<u>Fleet Captain: Diane Garrett</u> - The Dock is ready to go just waiting for nice weather to put it together and in the water.

<u>Bar Manager: ShaneDowling</u> - Shane is stepping down from Bar manager. Toni has been appointed the new bar manager.

<u>Bylaws Committee: Stan Jacques</u> - Has been considering a reorganization of the bylaws. There are new provisions that have been presented still wrestling with how and if we want those incorporated. The piece that was done put the bylaws in a more natural sequence. More information to come.

<u>Cruising Coordinator: Keith Chastain -</u> Rita has given him copies of social and race committee schedules. He will look at open dates to schedule cruise events.

<u>HR Committee: - Hillary Thomas/Dan Garrett -</u> New requirements for 2024 for employees: Moving forward staff will take the required training online. Dan drafted a policy to bring us up to date with California laws. <u>Membership Committee: Katie Dowling-</u> Thursday is hard for her to get here all the time so Tiffanny will cochair to fill in when Katies not here.

<u>Property Chairman-Frank Lewis</u> - Seawall - We're going to have to update the budget for the seawall. Just finished the wall in the back room. We have 3 large storage rooms. In the Annex there are 2 large storage rooms and several small ones. Frank's creating maps and what belongs in each area for each storage room. Board members will each get a copy, for all storage areas and what goes in them.

<u>Property Safety: Gary Skillett</u> - Rita reported that they will be doing a safety walk through the first part of February. All tenets will receive notice.

Race Director: Dan Garrett/Lara Jacques - Race committee met and we are now a committee of 3. Apps seminar 01/27 Dan Garrett leading. 02/03 safety equipment seminar. More details to come. Jim was presented with a race committee flag and pin.

<u>Social Committee: Lori Robinson - Committee meeting held last Saturday.</u> 12 members attended. Working on making an events postcard. Rita brought up board members hosting a month to get members to sign up to host friday night appetizers and monday night dinners. Lori suggests 2 dinners and 2 appetizers per month. <u>Workshop: Jim Brady - Workshop has become a storage area again.</u> It is currently difficult to work there. Need to find a different place to store stuff.

EYC BOARD UPDATE

DUES INCREASE



31 January 2024

To: Elkhorn Yacht Club Members,

In order to maintain the fiduciary health of our club, the EYC Board has increased the Flag Membership dues by \$25 per quarter at the 11 January 2024 meeting. Dues for other categories of membership will increase in accordance with the Bylaws. Without this increase we will be in deficit spending for fiscal year 2024.

California regulations have significantly increased wages for employees over the last several years. As a result the budget for wages has increased by approximately 20% in the last 5 years. Expenses for utilities, insurance, and maintenance have also had significant increases.

As we look at our aging property, there is much maintenance that is needed. The renovation of the women's bathroom in the annex has been at the top of the Capital Improvements list for several years and we are hoping to complete it this year.

Our Seawall needs repair at a cost of approximately \$30,000. We do not yet know the final costs as we are going through Monterey County and the Coastal Commission for the appropriate permits. This cost is only for consulting, materials and permitting as our members are providing volunteer labor.

Dues increases are never done lightly, but are necessary to maintain the spirit and beauty of our club for your enjoyment.




