

After a storm-drenched night, six crews showed up on Saturday, November 18 for the fifth and final race of the Chowder Cup series. Competitive spirit was high with a two-way series tie for first (Mariko and Northern Light) and a two-way series tie for second

(Cutlass and Solace), followed by Agua Knot and Un Bel Di. After the pre-race briefing, boats departed in a pouring rain for a 12:30 PM fleet start. Clouds parted and rainbows peeked out just before the race started. The fleet raced over a 7.6 nautical mile course from MLA (Moss Landing Mile Marker) to a virtual lat/long mark (MLV8) and back. 








#### THANKSGIVING AT ELKHORN YACHT CLUB
