**Description:**

Buoy racing will take place in the Moss Landing North Harbor. This is a family-friendly event featuring various sized sailing dinghies. Come test and improve your skills against other dinghy sailors. Boats may have a maximum length of 14 feet and will be subject to approval by the race committee. We look forward to seeing BIC's, Walker Bays, Lasers, Lidos, Fatty Knees, and other dinghies of a similar ilk. The goal is for a fun day with other dinghies!

**Eligibility and Requirements:**

This event is open to qualified dinghy sailors who can control their boat and have the ability to avoid obstacles such as kayaks, stationary boats, motor boats, and wildlife.

Each boat must be properly equipped for safety. **RACERS MUST WEAR A PERSONAL FLOTATION DEVICE.**

This year's event will be limited to 20 dinghies so sign up as soon as possible (see entry form).

**Registration and Fees:**

Entrance fee is \$20 per boat which includes prizes and one meal ticket for Elkhorn Yacht Club (EYC) "cook your own burger/dog" on the patio.

Burger choices – beef, salmon, veggie. Hot dog – Ball Park hot dog. Choice of a beer, house wine, or soft drink. Must be 21 years or older for beer or wine.

Launching is available right next to EYC at the Moss Landing North Harbor. The parking/launch fee is payable to Moss Landing Harbor District and includes a parking pass. Pay station is at the North Harbor public bathroom.

**Schedule:**

12:00 p.m. – Competitors meeting at the Elkhorn Yacht Club waterside patio.

1:00 p.m. – First race begins.

3:00 p.m. – Racing ends.

We will have as many races as time allows during the time period.

4:30 p.m. – Prizes/awards will be given out at the social gathering on the EYC waterside patio.

3:00 p.m. – 5:00 p.m. - Social get together. Family and spectators can purchase "cook your own burger/dog" plates at the bar. All guests are welcome to stay past the 5:00 p.m. event ending time!

Other: Sailing Instructions (SI) will be emailed to registered competitors and available at the competitors meeting.
